RULES, REGULATIONS AND FAQS

- * You are allowed to make teams of up to 3 members.

- * The answer can involve anything -- ciphers, math, technology, maps, music, books, pop culture references, or even IISc. The flag can be hidden in any way. Think outside the box!
- * We will announce hints at our discretion. Please don't ask for help with problems. We might reduce the points for the problem after the release of hints. So, try to solve the problems before the hints are released.
- * Posting flags or discussing in a public channel will lead to disqualification.
- * You must submit the flag in the format: dbdth{...}. Replace spaces with underscores and convert it to all lowercase. For example, if you think the answer is "007 james bond", you enter "dbdth{007_james_bond}". Use the \submit command of the Discord bot to submit your flags.
- * The answer can involve anything -- ciphers, math, technology, maps, music, books, pop culture references, or even IISc. The flag can be hidden in any way. Think outside the box!
- * Along with the main sequence of problems, there is also a set of bonus frenzy flags for you to find. They can be hidden anywhere and aren't tied to a specific problem. They are worth 5 points each. You can submit them anytime you want. You might also be given some frenzy-specific clues at 8:00 PM on both days. Note that other random frenzy flags can be released/found at any time during the event.
